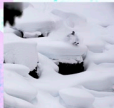

JIB LINE



RENO JIB

When the Sierra's get hammered, it's snowing in Northwest Reno. Ten years ago we waited for morning to ski. Things have changed and now we are hitting urban rails around town on snowy nights and riding fresh park all day. We designed the Reno Jib with this in mind. These dimensionally symmetrical boards are for the modern park skier. Their massive pop comes from a burly and stiff yet lightweight construction. The Reno Jib will handle the abuse of today's terrain parks and urban destruction.



RENO ROCKER

There's no such thing as last call in Nevada, and we don't believe in last chair either. Mountains under the sun and urban under the moon. With a fatter profile than the Jib, this ski is amazing for more than just the confines of ski areas. The Rocker is another one of our symmetrical skis, offering the same feel when you're going forward or switch. The rockered profile makes this ski amazing for butters, rails, and anything of the sort - anytime of day.



THE BIBBY

It didn't take Josh Bibby long to get to work on his signature ski. He was at the factory in Reno making his first pair of prototypes only days after joining our team. The original pair was based off the 07/08 limited production Melee, but after several revisions it became a new ski. With a rockered profile and a medium flex, the ski is exactly what Josh needed for Interior British Columbia riding. Although this ski is at home in the backcountry, it can still handle the entire mountain with ease.



DONNER PARTY

This ski's parent design is just as much a piece of Sierra history as the Donner Party members themselves. It's only fitting the next generation of this design comes from a Sierra based company. The rocker design is flat under foot and curved up toward the tip and tail, making them incredibly maneuverable in shallow snow and buoyant in the deep. The continuous reverse sidecut allows for surf like turns and easy slashes. All this paired with our lightweight construction and moderately stiff flex make these the most fun powder boards ever.

RENO FREEBIRD

166, 176, 182, 192

Originally created for the park, this ski became more of an all-mountain ripper. With the most sidecut in our line and a progressive flex getting stiffer in the tail this ski maneuvers effortlessly. It's stable platform handles speed and anything else you roll in its way. Unlike the slots of Reno, this ski is a sure bet!



TAHOE

170, 180, 188

Conceived with Tahoe's shifty climate in mind, this ski will weather various conditions. Light pow and first chair, Sierra Cement by noon, pond skimming at 2 pm and ice skating the next morning - it's all in Tahoe. With the moderate flex and versatile sidecut, there's no need for a midday ski exchange. The Tahoe is truly your do-it-all ski.



RUBY

180, 188, 190

The Ruby Mountains rise high above the Nevada desert floor, snagging dry powder from Pacific storms. Like its Nevada birthplace, the Ruby ski captures your soul with its liveliness in powder. Each size has its own unique identity, allowing you to find a Ruby that's right for you. The 180 is a more versatile ski, with a progressive flex and a deeper sidecut. The 188 has an overall soft flex, ample tip and tail, and a larger footprint making it a powder hound. Rounding out the line, our Ruby 190 contains a stiffer flex throughout and longer effective edge, making this a great directional charger.

With its modern boot center and extremely stiff flex, taming this lion is a snap. The M1 will instill confidence in all conditions, it can handle it. The M1 is also offered with a rockered tip for increased performance in softer snow.

SPADE

156, 176, 182, 192

The Spade was based off the ever popular Reno Freebird. It's slightly modified flex pattern makes this women's ski the best for all-mountain riding. It has an extremely stable platform ready for any obstacle the mountain may present you with. Make a sure bet, bet on the Spade.



SIERRA

The Sierra, like it's name sake, is accustomed to large amounts of snow. While it's width and even flex react well in the deep, it can still handle crud and hard pack conditions. The sierra is a tough girl who can handle whatever Mother Nature has to offer.

Our biggest request from women skiers was a women-specific fat ski. Here is our gift to you; the Pika. At 112mm underfoot, this is one of the widest women-specific skis on the market. It's medium flex and subtle sidecut make it the ultimate powder ski.
