







FAQ's with founder and Chief Ski Officer Erik Boone

Q: What is your Company's Story?

Boone is a fiercely independent skier owned and operated company based out of California but comprised of individuals from all over the world who are absolutely obsessed with Freeskiing. Our passion is skiing and our core values are service, quality, and creativity.

This all comes from our roots. Growing up as a kid in Idaho, it was a childhood dream of mine to create an innovative and independent ski company right here in the USA that would be run by skiers. The goal is to have the ear of the customer and build them the skis they want to ride. Our committment to pursuing green manufacturing practices is evident in our use of bamboo a renewable resource, as the core material in each of our skis.

We hand-build our skis designed by skiers and adorned by artists - with the goal to deliver the best skis to our customers at a reasonable price. BOONE is about sharing our passion for skiing with the rest of the world through the production of our skis, supporting up and coming young skiers, increasing the number of people who ski around the world, and working with partner retailers who share our enthusiasm.

Q: What makes BOONE unique?

We allow our customers to customize their skis. At BOONESKIS.com customers can choose the type of ski (current models include the BOONE PARK, FREEride or POWder Reverse Camber (RC Powder)) and then choose their favorite BOONE artwork to put on their ski as well as pick their desired ski length* and build their own personal and unique skis! We only produce up to 250 pairs of any ski and often we'll produce 25 pairs or less of any given model to ensure each pair of BOONE skis are rare and artistically unique.

*Customers can pick from any of the the ski lengths we offer.

In addition, we've used bamboo as the core material in every pair of skis that we've ever sold. Bamboo is extremely lightweight, strong, fast-growing (green building material) and provides and awesome medium flex pattern that provides for that panda-pop. Bamboo - It's nature's carbon fiber!

Artwork is a major focus for BOONE Skis and has been from day one. I feel like I'm surrounded by amazing artists working at D-Structure San Francisco. This has been a huge inspiration for us to push the limits in this artistic arena of ski building. I believe skiing is the perfect fusion of art and sport and as such it only makes sense to put the most arresting and unique artwork on our skis. If you feel our artwork is lacking please let us know - we'd love to hear from you and see a sample of the next piece of truly innovative topsheet artwork.



Q: What's your most popular ski?

Our hottest selling ski is a moving target but my favorite is our RC POWder (140/119/138) ski. It has a bamboo core and, as with all of our skis, it is built with a vertically laminated bamboo core and quality sandwich construction. The ski is a fully rockered (40/30)* powder tool that absolutely rips up the powder. This is my favorite ski because it also is awesome in the park, in the crud, and in spring conditions. We currently have several pieces of artwork to choose from on this particular ski, including the popular "Glo-Sticks," "Underdog," "Spaceghost," "Tron," and "B-1." *To simplify things we label all our Reverse Camber skis in this way. 40/30 RC indicates 30mm of reverse camber beginning 40cm in from the tip and tail. ie: a 30/15 would be 15mm of reverse camber 30mm in from the tip and 30mm from the tail.

TECHNOLOGY & CONSTRUCTION

Our ski line up this year includes our Park/All Mountain, Freeride, RC POWder. All of our skis feature vertically laminated bamboo cores matched twith ABS sidewalls, Rockwell 48 edges, triaxial fiberglass, sintered P-Tex 4000, high density PBT with ultraprint graphics, and eco friendly Entropy resin.

Vertically Laminated Bamboo core allows for lighter skis with more pop, and longer lasting camber.


